
••• Medicals International 2nd Contact Lens Scientific Day

••• Just Like Clothing, Contact Lenses Have to Fit!

We are very blessed to be working in a progressive industry. Recent studies show that global soft contact lens market expected to reach \$12.6 billion by 2027 with Compound Annual Growth Rate (CAGR%) of 6.8% over the period 2020 -2027, and it has been segmented into the following categories for the next 7-year period:

- Daily Soft Contact Lens is projected to record 7.8% CAGR

- Weekly Replacement Lens segment is expected to reach 6.9% CAGR

- Monthly Replacement Lens Segment to Record 5.9% CAGR.

According to the world health organization globally an estimated 153M people are suffering from uncorrected refractive errors, this increasing prevalence of ocular disorders due to changing in the Demographic factors including aging population, growing urbanization, and rise in diabetic incidences is anticipated to fuel market growth. Also, the growing awareness about the therapeutic potential of contact lenses which combined with significant rise in R&D activities in the field of optometry and optics are other factors that increased the global market growth.

The main challenge within the contact lenses business is the high dropout rate. Despite the many technologies, developments and lunching of new contact lenses and care solutions, the dropout numbers from more than 25 years ago remain largely unchanged today, approximately one-third of lens wearers had dropped out, due to discomfort, dryness symptoms, poor vision and challenges with insertion and removal.

Studies showed that small reductions in dropout rates can result in significant changes in the overall lens wearer base, if we could reduce the dropout rate by as little as 3.5% yearly between 2020 and 2040, we could double the number of contact lens wearers in our practices. Therefore, the main aim is to attempt to reduce the dropout rate, by paying greater attention to all components of the contact lens fit, lenses, modality and care products, patient education on proper wearing habits, cleaning and care and comprehensive follow up specially with new wearers, all play a significant role in increasing customers retention. One of the most common causes of contact lenses dropout is the distorted vision, which results from wearing the wrong contact lens prescription, especially astigmatic cases in which astigmatism is left uncorrected despite the availability of toric contact lenses. Approximately 47% of patients have 0.75 D of astigmatism or more in at least one eye, but toric contact lenses, are only fitted on approximately 25% of patients. In relatively recent history it may have appeared sensible to 'hold-off' recommending soft toric contact lenses for lower amounts of astigmatism; the lenses were more expensive, fitting took longer, and ultimately vision may not have been significantly improved over a spherical lens, with comfort potentially being worse, but Today's soft toric designs and materials offer better optics, improved stability, a wider range of stock parameters and the option of daily disposability, so prescribing contact lenses should be no different than prescribing glasses, Just as practitioner would fully prescribe cylindrical correction in spectacles - with some exception-, it is equally as important to fully correct astigmatism in contact lenses, even for those patients with low cylinder, because uncorrected astigmatism results in reduced visual acuity, which can make a significant difference in visual comfort.

The growth of the contact lens market is just one of many optical market trends that Eye Care Professionals should watch to keep up with the wants and needs of their patients/customers. If you offer customer-centric eye care, based on education and retention, you'll be providing your patients with the best products and services. It means working smarter, not harder to achieve better outcomes for your customers. If we can prevent dropouts from occurring, we can recapture a significant amount of income for our bottom line while taking better care of patients. That's why we've been always at Medicals International "We Think of The Patient First".

I have been working as a Cornea and Refractive surgeon for the past 22 years. Throughout my career, I have adopted and adapted to many technologies that served my subspecialty and more so, my patients. In 2012, I began my journey with femtolaser machines and since then I became a die hard fan. I perform 100% of my Lasik procedures and corneal transplant procedure with the femtolaser. I have numerous publications on different femtosecond laser keratoplasty techniques and have lectured extensively on this topic in different parts of the world.

Last year, I decided to add the Ziemer Z8 to our armamentarium at Dar El Oyoun Private Eye Hospital in Cairo. With the outstanding support of Medicals International, we expressed our wish to acquire the Ziemer as well as the Schwind Amaris Excimer laser machine and they paved all the way and in no time we had both machines.

Me, being a seasoned refractive and corneal surgeon who has spent decades using top notch machines, I thought that this combo would definitely satisfy my patients needs and will perform up to my expectations, just as other high end competition platforms do...

I was wrong, these two machines outsmarted all other platforms and Femto/Excimer suites I have used. The

performance is truly unparalleled. To enumerate all the advantages over competition, I will need a whole edition of this journal but I will just outline few advantages;



Regarding the ZIEMER S FEMTE LEX 28, the mobility and versatility of this machine is simply unbelievable. We run a high volume keratoplasty service and having the machine in the OR just next to the microscope is simply awesome. I have videos and presentations on how to avoid loosing the anterior chamber of the patient after the laser cut during transportation from the laser room to the OR. These presentations now are totally useless with the laser machine just next to you and no need to transport the patient at all. This really is a game changer. As for the capabilities of the laser in performing much more complicated wound architecture than other machines as well as the INGENIOUS

DALK tunnel which makes the procedure reproducible even in trainees' hands. The ability of placing ICRS at different depths of the cornea according to the different thickness in different zones, the almost "bubbleless" division of the nucleus in Femto-Cataract surgery all are just a few of many advantages.



As for the **SCHURCE AMERIS 500** that is another story. We purchased the system with the very capable Ocular Wavefront aberrometer PERAMIS and the Superb Tomographer SIRIUS. They waltz together and provide me with a TRUE usable full profile for my patients' optical system. I have been doing wavefront guided treatments since 2004 but I was never able to scan different areas in the pupil and know the exact wavefront error in it, then compare this with the corneal tomography. I was never able to choose which HOA to treat and avoid the treatment of HOAs that

are clinically insignificant to decrease my ablation depth and save corneal tissue, again these are just a few for the many superiorities of the Schwind AMARIS over other Excimer machines.



Having these two machines at our center has really enhanced our Refractive and Anterior Segment services, and above all, has made my OR day a real pleasure. Thank you MI for putting peace in our surgeons' minds and smiles on our patients faces.

Ever since I got involved in the dry eye disease (DED) realm, I am constantly amazed with how much morbidity this condition can cause to patients. It is reported that its prevalence can reach up to 30%, with the most recent description being that it is "a multifactorial disease of the ocular surface characterized by a loss of homeostasis of the tearfilm, accompanied by symptoms, tearfilm instability and hyperosmolarity, ocular surface inflammation, damage, and neurosensory abnormalities" (DEWS II report, 2017). For this reason, artificial tears alone are not always effective.

I started using the E-Eye machine E>Eye (ESW-Vision, France) in 2019. I already treated more than 25 patients with DED with pulses given at d0, w2, and w6. This Intense Regulated Pulsed Light/Ocular Pulsed Light machine (IRPL/OPL) delivers high intensity, regulated pulsed light that results in meibomian gland warming, vascular coagulation, neural stimulation, decrease in Demodex load, and connective tissue remodeling. The treatment is fast, regulated, and office-based: patients get the treatment and continue their day with no effect on their activities, thus continuing their day normally. In my experience, all tested patients reported improvement in their symptoms within the first two weeks with decreased reliance on artificial tears. Objective measures were also improved in subsequent clinical visits.

In conclusion, we currently have a new alternative to artificial tears and a good additive to our armamentarium of treatment options for patients with DED.

••• LDV Z8 Case Study

Introducing the Ziemer LDV Z8 laser platform into our practice at Moorfields Eye Center, Abu



Dhabi has proven to be an excellent choice. The versatility of the platform allows me to perform both routine cataract and refractive cases, and more complex corneal transplant procedures.

The pictures on the right are an example of a "Tuck in" femtosecond laser assisted penetrating keratoplasty for a case of very advanced keratoconus, where the central keratometry readings were over 70 diopters. The peripheral cornea of this


patient has a thickness of 208 microns. Performing a conventional PKP would cause a gross disparity in thicknesses of the donor and recipient.

A "tuck in" PKP procedure where the brim of a donor cornea cut in a "top hat" configuration slots into a groove formed in the peripheral cornea of the recipient, avoids any such donor-recipient disparity.

This creates a dove tail configuration wound where there is less graft host mismatch in terms of thickness and faster healing due to more surface area of the graft host interface, as can be seen in the pre and

While facing the battle for political stability through intense civil protests, the Lebanese citizens braced themselves for a new battle against COVID-19: a virus pandemic that has brought the entire world to a standstill.

Lebanon documented its first covid case on February 21st since then our CC team has been relentless equipping, training, supporting hospitals and health care professionals throughout this pandemic.



The Lebanese American University had published a paper in early March forecasting that Lebanon would have 13,217 infections with approximately 454 deaths by the summer of 2020, even with the application of COVID measures such as masks and social distancing. Without the lockdown, researchers predicted that there would have been a substantial number of 2.5 million infections and a dramatic 150,000 deaths.

The Lebanese health care system has played a crucial role in the containment of the pandemic. The Rafik Al Hariri University Hospital has emerged as the nation's vanguard against novel coronavirus, caring for the health of patients from all social classes in these rough times. Following intense preparation on coronavirus operational centers, the private sector has joined the fight against the disease, aiding in the mission of continuing to contain the epidemic.

United with other distributors, Medicals International has supplied hospitals and NGOs with much needed respiratory equipment. The Critical Care line that Medicals International provides rose dramatically up the leaderboard due to its Getinge ICU ventilators. Moreover, with the rising demand for ventilators, repurposing anesthesia machines such as the Flow-i, Flow-c, and Flow-e anesthesia machines, to use when ventilating ICU patients, was an essential step taken by the company. In addition, Medicals International supplied a great number of hospital beds which is significant to patient care.

Lebanon is not out of the woods just yet, the path to normal life seems terrifyingly long; however, as a company, and most importantly as part of the community, Medicals International is completely committed to keeping on taking the necessary measures to support hospitals and doctors until the very end of this disastrous pandemic.


••• A Personal Experience with Astra Tech Implant System

This is a part of a prospective study I am conducting, where till now, more than 550 Astra

implants were placed in more than 300 sinuses by applying this technique (for over 5 years). The collected data shows 100% clinical and radiological success rate with high satisfaction of the patient and the referring dentists because of both the efficacy and the speed of the treatment. These results are in direct relation with the primary stability I was able to get with the Astra implants and their high ability to integrate in shallow grafted sinuses.

At 6:07 PM, on the 4th of August, 2020, while the capital of Lebanon was as active and busy as ever, a catastrophic blast killed over 200 innocent citizens, injured 6,500, left 350,000 homeless, and broke the hearts of millions. The explosion left the Lebanese public vulnerable, heavily damaging a large part of the critical health infrastructure. The damage caused was unparalleled and universal bringing to ground homes, schools, offices. A month after this dreadful explosion, our president Mr. Walid Barake reflects on this terrible tragedy:

Dear Colleagues, Partners & Friends,

At the onset of the Beirut explosion, I wrote to you with my personal reflection of the moment as truly the horror of seeing the apocalyptic damage was beyond imagination & the surreal scene was beyond description. One month through this explosion today where; human losses close to 200 buried in emotionally heartbreaking funerals and processions whilst few are still missing under the Beirut rubbles. The injuries toll crossed 6000 people and the material losses touched over 300 000 households.

Every Lebanese and much of the world was touched morally and emotionally, and the tragedy echoed globally with so many friends rushing to help. Medicals International was active as the below pictures depict very clearly from day one; our team was on the streets rushing hot meals to displaced families and offering a hand of help on so many levels. Then our local corporate leaders, Medicals Beirut office, as you can see in the photos, got fully engaged to rebuild the Rosaire Hospital Eye Center, which includes a fully equipped unit including an advanced Excimer & Femtosecond lasers.



The destruction was massive yet our contractors and service engineers are soon to get the full unit operational. MI, in parallel, was open in day 2 to receive graduates looking for a job and hired 4 new staff, offering hope amid desperation.

Disasters & upheavals bring the best out of people. I was told and I can attest today that this was the case in Lebanon with teenage students on the streets helping others, to people from all corners of the globe reaching out to help and already doing so. This is humanity at its true meaning and despite the agony of the explosion new hope was born.

I want to take this opportunity to thank all of our dear partners, customers and friends who called and extended moral and material help. Beirut will be back to life and Medicals will continue to be an icon of hope in this region that we all cherish and work hard to make a better place for generations to prosper.
